

VERY IMPORTANT New Garbage Procedures as of Sept 1st, 2017

As of September 1st, 2017, garbage will always be collected on Mondays and Thursdays – all year round, except for the holidays listed below.

IMPORTANT: Garbage will be collected starting at 6:30AM. You must put your garbage out after 5pm, but it must be put out the night before garbage collection. Your garbage might be missed if you don't get it out by 6AM.

Bulky waste (NOT CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS) will be picked up on the first and last Thursday pickup of the month, unless that Thursday is Christmas, New Year's or Thanksgiving. You are responsible for getting rid of your own construction debris.

Garbage will be collected on Mondays and Thursdays, except if Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Years falls on one of those days...then the garbage will be picked up on the following scheduled day. For example, Thanksgiving is on Thursday, so garbage will not be picked up until the following Monday.

If trash collection falls on a minor holiday (Memorial Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, MLK, President's Day, Good Friday, Veterans Day, or Fourth of July) it will be collected on the holiday.

Recycling is picked up every Tuesday - one week paper and cardboard is picked up and the next cans and bottles are picked up. Plastic bags are not allowed.

Metal (appliances, bed frames, etc) and electronics (tvs, printers, computers) are picked up every Thursday, except if Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Years fall on a Thursday. If that happens, that week's pick up is skipped. If you want to have a freezer or refrigerator picked up, you need to go to Borough Hall for a permit.

Yard waste (grass, leaves, and branches) is picked up on Wednesdays, and must be in brown paper bags, or in garbage cans, or tied. NO PLASTIC BAGS for yard waste. Yard waste collection ends in December.

Real Christmas trees are picked up in January, on Wednesday. They cannot have wires, or ornaments, or tinsel on them.

Yard waste collection resumes in March.
