Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that there are still two outstanding issues with the contractor for the DPW Building, one is the sprinkler system, and that has to be up to the Port Authority and NFPA code, also, the soil which has to be brought to the site. He mentioned that the architect approved the soil but Tricon has not brought it yet. Everything inside is finished except for the garage floor. Also, mentioned that the building department cannot issue a TCO or CO unless it is okayed by the Port Authority, there is a conference call tomorrow on the project.

 Mr. Dobiszewski mentioned that he heard back from the County earlier today, and they completed the plan layout, and the Graycliff will not be affected.

 Mayor Vaccaro mentioned they were looking to take the opposite side of the street by the gas station and the Russo property which are not located in Moonachie, then they would have to get approval and enter into an agreement with Carlstadt.
- 3. Energy efficiency for Municipal Building.

C/Martinez mentioned that he will meet with the Financial Consultant.

4. Community Development Block Grant.

Administrator Ciannamea spoke about the Community Development Grant and that the next round of funding is available but there are still two projects open for the Civic Center.

Mayor Vaccaro suggested to contact Community Development to see if the money from the other two grants that were awarded can be moved for the HVAC project.

5. Moving Court to Municipal Building.

Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that the County came to visit and there are a couple of things that have to be done. Phone lines and the television in the hallway can only be used for Court, may be moving one of the televisions into the lobby downstairs for the Borough to use.

7. Salary Ordinance.

Administrator Ciannamea spoke about the 2021 Salary Ordinance notes. They were reviewed by the Financial Consultant. Spoke about one of the items on the notes, and the part time maintenance worker.

Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that they made \$15.29 and in 2021 with a 2% increase it would be \$16.24.

Mayor and Council discussed the hourly rate for the Part Time Maintenance Worker. Mayor Vaccaro confirmed with the Council that the rate would be \$19.25 per hour. Administrator Ciannamea spoke about the note on the Salary Ordinance about Court personnel. Mentioned that there was a conflict

Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that then there is no one in the position and it would need to be filled.

Mayor and Council discussed the Part Time Violations Clerk salary which will be rolled into other base salary, and the hiring of a Part Time Violations Clerk.

Administrator Ciannamea suggested the range for the salary in the Ordinance should be higher and up to \$5,000, because it would be for Teterboro and Moonachie Court.

8. Pet Waste Ordinance.

The Mayor and Council discussed the Ordinance. There is a model ordinance from the Department of Environmental Protection.

C/Cirillo mentioned that next Wednesday is the celebration for the Senior Club's 50th Anniversary.

C/Kinsella asked if the Borough has to do anything for the Seniors. Mentioned that the Ragamuffin Parade will be on Saturday October 30^{th} .

Attorney Migliorino spoke about Teterboro's contract for Police Services and the easement on Anderson Avenue.

C/Bauer asked about who is responsible for the repair of the easement for any work done by the Borough.

Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that the information on responsibility would be included in the easement, and that the Borough would need to have access to the area if it arises.

Mayor Vaccaro mentioned that the Borough ordered a plaque to give the Seniors at their anniversary party.
