WHEREAS, such special legal services can be provided by a recognized bond counsel firm, and the law firm of DeCotiis, FitzPatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP, Teaneck, New Jersey is so recognized by the financial community

dollars of notes issued up to \$15,000,000 and \$.40 per thousand dollars of notes in excess of \$15,000,000, plus if more than one (1) series of notes are issued, \$500 for each additional series.

Any additional services shall be at the standard hourly rates (the hourly rates range from \$120.00 to \$250.00 per hour).

If the Bond sale involves the sale of obligations to the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development or an application to the Local Finance Board, such services fee will be hourly rate range from \$120.00 to \$250.00, with a minimum fee of \$1,500.00 and if the bond or note sale involved participation in a New Jersey Infrastructure Bank financing, such service shall be at the standard hourly rates, with a minimum fee of \$2,500.00.
