**ORDINANCE #BH-22-001
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. BH-21-002
AN ORDINANCE REGARDING FERAL CATS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Moonachie, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey effectuated Ordinance No. BH-21-002 due to the proliferation of feral cats and feral cat colonies throughout the State including the Borough of Moonachie ("Borough"), which has resulted in a growing number of feral cat colonies; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been advised of the presence of a scrivener's error in the definition of the term "DAYLIGHT HOURS" in article 1 of the above-referenced Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of Moonachie, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Ordinance BH-21-002 Article 1, entitled Definitions is hereby amended to replace the definition or meaning of the term "DAYLIGHT HOURS" as follows:

DAYLIGHT HOURS

Hours during the day after dawn until dusk.

2. No other provision is modified, amended or otherwise deleted unless set forth in this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
