Report from Health Inspector Maria Schmitt:

**Dog Bite-** They are going to court with Animal Control. There was another dog bite on Henry Street, the dog bit the mailman, but he was not able to tell which dog bit him, and all the dogs were impounded by Animal Control. Mentioned that they hope the dogs can be readopted. There was no problem with rabies, but the owners may not be getting the dogs back.

**Vanguard-** went by a few times, there have been no problems.

Metropolitan- complaint about the dumpster and wildlife, and investigator found that they were recycling improperly.

M. Cinque asked about the bedbugs and wildlife feeding complaint on the report. Maria mentioned that a social worker contacted her. Mentioned that the school has put something out that notifies parents, but they can not name the student or the class they are in. That would be up to the Board of Education. The nurse would likely know who it is.
