1.New DPW Building Construction.

the bonding company, there are two items that need to be finished, one is the steel calculation on the decking and the pad for the outside condenser, these items are needed for the Port Authority before a C.O would be issued. Also, mentioned that the floors have to be sealed before moving in, and the contractor has not brought soil to the site
